Rhododendron Festival: May 25-June 2, 2019

Thousands of world-famous rhododendrons in over 100 varieties offer an explosion of spectacular blooms throughout Heritage Museums & Gardens at 67 Grove Street in Sandwich. Enjoy a peaceful walk surrounded by walls of flowers, learn more about Heritage's storied rhododendron legacy, engage with horticulture experts, and take home one of these signature plants from the special plant sale.

Arts Alive Festival: June 21-June 23, 2019

Free Fun for the Entire Family! ArtsFalmouth and Falmouth Village Association present Arts Alive, a three-day arts festival with events and activities for all members of the family. 60 performances of music, theater, and dance take place on the Falmouth Library Lawn. Exhibits and Cape Cod artists and craftspeople, offering their works for sale, will be held on Shore Street Extension. Food and drink available, face painting, balloons and a tent with arts activities for the young.

Strawberry Festival: June 22, 2019

The gorgeous grounds of St. Barnabas Church at 91 Main Street, Falmouth, adjacent to the Town Green in Falmouth, is the setting for this annual strawberry festival. Enjoy strawberry treats, lobster rolls, hot dogs, and barbecued chicken on the St. Barnabas lawn. There will also be arts and crafts vendors, a plant sale, and activities and games for kids.

An annual event starting at 10am that raises money for local Falmouth charities, it's held in August on the day before the Falmouth Road Race, and was founded in 1991 by local celebrities Eddie Doyle and Tommy Leonard. Register online, or at the Quarterdeck Restaurant on August 16th, 4:30-7:30PM. The Falmouth Walk will step off at 10AM from Falmouth Town Hall Square. The distance is 3.2 miles. A picnic and raffle will follow.

Falmouth Road Race: August 18, 2019

The world class New Balance Falmouth Road Race celebrates its 47th running this year and the spirit which made the first Falmouth so special is still present today. More than 12,000 runners will gather in Woods Hole for the 2019 renewal, including many of the world's elite, though the essence of the event remains a fun run. Back-of-the-pack joggers share the road with the best, forming a tapestry of colors from the start on Water Street to the finish at the beach in Falmouth Heights.
